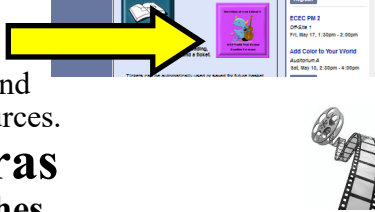

Register

Reading Logs



You earn books and prize tickets by reading. You keep track of the amount of time you spend reading with our paper reading log & online summer reader program. Here is how the reading log works:

- On your first visit, take a Reading Log and write your name/phone number on it.
- Use the paper log to keep track of time spent reading wherever you are, transfer your time to the online summer reader log when you can get to a computer.
- 20 Hour Reading Logs** have small boxes. Color in a square for each 15 minutes you read. Each row of four boxes equals one hour.
- When you have completed five hours of reading, record the title and author of the book you read on your paper log. If you read more than one book, choose your favorite title to write down.
- You earn a book, a ticket for the iPad Mini, and a ticket for the basket drawings.
- Write your name and phone number on the tickets and enter it in to the drawing of your choice. iPad tickets are only for the iPad drawing and basket tickets are only for the basket drawings.
- Earn one extra basket ticket by visiting the library six times throughout the summer. Be sure to have your reading log stamped at the check-out desk each time you visit.
