IV. Public Hearing as to the Budget and Appropriation Ordinance – Ordinance #7 2018 for the Wood Dale Public Library District July 1, 2018 – June 30, 2019

President Winger opened the Public Hearing as to the Budget and Appropriation Ordinance – Ordinance #7 2018 for the Wood Dale Public Library District for July 1, 2018– June 30, 2019 and read the following opening statement:

“Section 1: This is Public Hearing as to the Budget and Appropriation Ordinance- Ordinance #7 2018 for the Wood Dale Public Library District for the Fiscal Year Beginning July 1, 2018 and Ending June 30, 2019.

Section 2: In accordance with Illinois Statutes, the Wood Dale Public Library District published a “Legal Notice” of the public hearing on Wednesday, August 15, 2018. This notice was published in the DuPage County Chronicle which is circulated throughout DuPage County and the surrounding area.
