I. Call to Order:

President Dunn called the Public Hearing as to the Budget and Appropriation Ordinance – Ordinance #8 2021 for the Wood Dale Public Library District July 1, 2021 – June 30, 2022 to order on September 13, 2021 at 7:15 pm at the Wood Dale Park District Recreation Complex at 111 E. Foster Avenue, Wood Dale, Illinois, 60191.

IV. Public Hearing as to the Budget and Appropriation Ordinance – Ordinance #8 2021 for the Wood Dale Public Library District July 1, 2021 – June 30, 2022

President Dunn opened the Public Hearing as to the Budget and Appropriation Ordinance – Ordinance #8 2021 for the Wood Dale Public Library District for July 1, 2021 – June 30, 2022 and read the following opening statement:

“Section 1: This is Public Hearing as to the Budget and Appropriation Ordinance- Ordinance #8 2021 for the Wood Dale Public Library District for the Fiscal Year Beginning July 1, 2021 and Ending June 30, 2022.

Section 2: In accordance with Illinois Statutes, the Wood Dale Public Library District published a “Legal Notice” of the public hearing on Wednesday, August 11, 2021. This notice was published in the DuPage County Chronicle which is circulated throughout DuPage County and the surrounding area.

Section 3: The Ordinance in Tentative Form (Tentative Budget and Appropriation Ordinance – Ordinance #7 2021) was available for public inspection for at least thirty days prior to this hearing on the Main Library Lobby posting board at 520 North Wood Dale Road, Wood Dale, Illinois and the Administrative Office at the Library Programming Center at 140 School Street, Wood Dale, Illinois. This notice was also published on our Website.

Section 4: If there is any person who desires to present testimony to this taxing district, wanting to present testimony to this taxing district represented by the Board of Library Trustees of the Wood Dale Public Library District, please step forward at this time.”

Director Bergendorf informed the Board of Library Trustees the Library had not received any written or verbal communication to communicate to the Board of Library Trustees for the Public Hearing.
