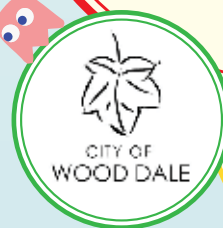

### **Coffee Service at the Library**

Access to Boundless will stop beginning July 1. You may not be able to access eBooks or eAudiobooks that you have currently checked out or your reading history. Please take advantage of the Library's other eBook and eAudiobook services, Libby and Hoopla. We're consolidating and focusing our efforts on building these two services. 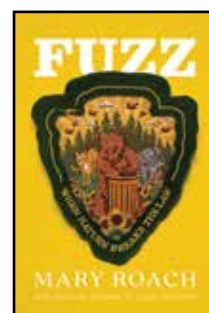
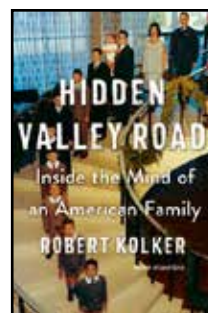
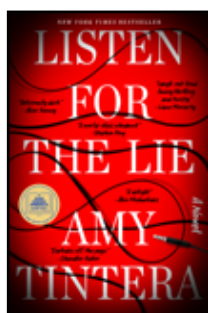
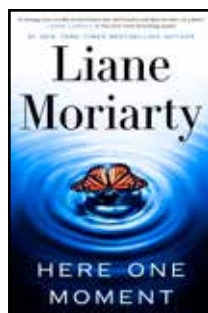
## BOOK CLUBS & AUTHOR VISITS

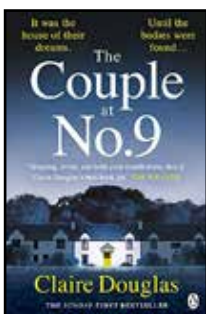

500 Books Before Junior High is for children in kindergarten to 5th grade. It continues to encourage children to be read to as well as to read independently. We want children to choose books that will engage them, inform them, and be fun to read so that **reading** becomes an enjoyable daily activity. You can repeat books! Read fiction, graphic novels, and non-fiction – **READ BOOKS YOU ENJOY!** Sharing books and encouraging reading time will help them develop a love of reading and learning that will last a lifetime.

Pick up a paper bookmark log or use our Beanstack app to record every 50 books read. You can choose a paperback book to keep for every 50 books your read. Remember, children have six years to complete this program.
