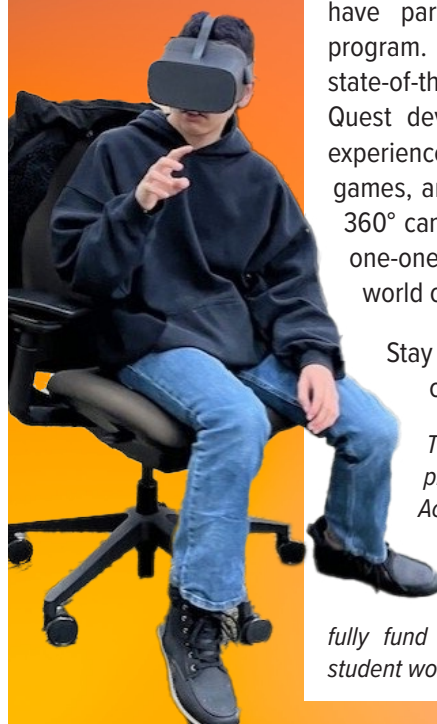

HAVE YOU HEARD THE BUZZ ABOUT VR?

Librarians from the Wood Dale Public Library and the Bensenville Community Public Library have been working on an exciting new project!



Over the past six months, more than eighty students have participated in the Exploring Virtual Reality program. Students gained hands-on experience with state-of-the-art VR technology, including Pico and Meta Quest devices. They learned fundamental VR skills, experienced immersive virtual field trips, played exciting games, and even crafted their own virtual tours using 360° cameras. A group of teen mentors worked one-one-one with students as they discovered the exciting world of VR.

Stay tuned for upcoming VR programs for both children and adults!

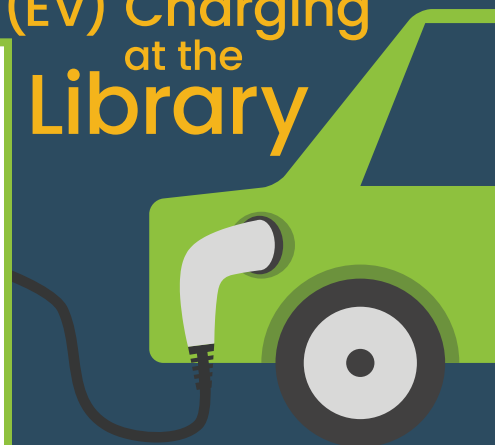
This program is made possible through the funding provided by the Library Services and Technology Act (LSTA) funds (CFDA 45.310). These funds are allocated to the Illinois State Library by the Institute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS), and the Wood Dale Public Library received \$30,066 to fully fund this program's equipment, seasonal/temporary student workers, and training.

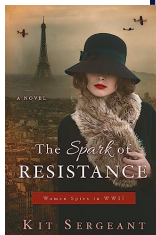

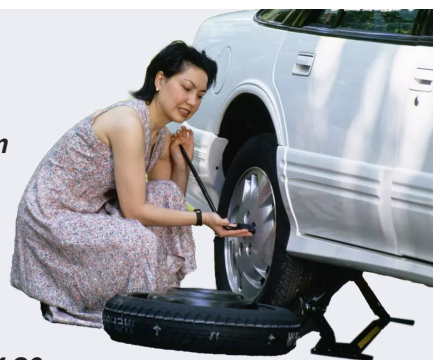

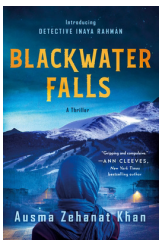


The Bean Trees by Barbara Kingsolver

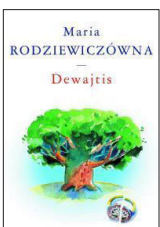

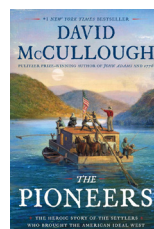
